A.O.C : Bordeaux Rouge

VARIETY : Merlot 60 % Cabernet Sauvignon 40 %

PLANTING : 25 years ago

DENSITY: 3300 vines/hectare

YIELD : 50 hectolitres/hectare

PRUNING : Guyot simple

ALTITUDE: 60 to 80 m

ASPECT : East-West facing land

TERROIR: Limestone clay

DISTRICT : Faleyras

VINIFICATION : Vatting for 12 days at 25°C to bring out the red fruit aromas. Malo-lactic fermentation to obtain the suppleness typical of a good wine.

AGEING : Traditional in tank, 18 months.

TASTING : Deep, sustained colour. Red fruits aromas.

Powerful entry but supple with very tight tannins.

SERVING : 16 to 18°C

AGEING : 6 to 8 years

ACCOMPANIMENT : Pork meat, red meat, cheeses.
