Rias Baixas, Spain



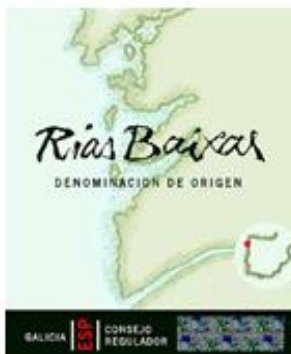
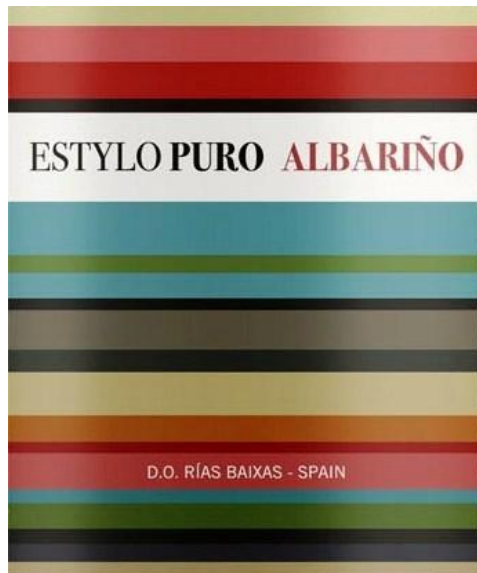
The DO “Rías Baixas” begins in 1980 with the recognition of the Albariño designation one of the most dynamic designations of origin, and with wider international growth due to the fact that the Albariño variety, *indigenous* to this area, enjoys suitable conditions of climate and soil.

Bodegas Carballal is family operated by the Vazquez family and it is located in a historical sub- zone of O Salnés, home of the origin of the Albariño variety and the most important Denominación de Origen; the River Umiá flows throughout this valley, sheltered on both banks by the hillsides of mounts Castrove, Lobeira and Xiabre.

Tasting Notes

Bright, straw yellow color, Intense fresh aromas of peach, apricot and melon, floral notes and some minerality are also found. Nice body, an inviting and crisp acidity and a long finish.

Matching: It is an excellent aperitif wine as well as great with fish, seafood, sushi, rice, white meats, cheese and foie gras. Optimal serving temperature of 10°C; an ice bucket is advised in summer to keep a drinking temperature of 12-14°C. The Bordeaux white wine glass is a fine choice.
