



Hermann Moser Pinot Blanc Beerenauslese



The Wolfsgaben vineyard was first documented in 1284, this vineyard is well known for its deep, fat, loamy soil producing great wines combining rich fruits and great acidity.

Production Area: Wolfsgaben (wolf's ditch) vineyard in Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria

Grape Variety: 100% Pinot Blanc

Vinification and Aging: Picked at optimum ripeness the fruits were left to macerate for 12 hours, fermented using indigenous yeast and left to mature in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Notes: Deep golden color. On the nose: exotic fruits such as lychee and passion fruit with a hint of flowers. On the palate it is lush with great acidity, fresh and rich at the same time with a lingering finish.

Serving suggestions: This Pinot Blanc Beerenauslese will go very well with pan fried chicken or duck liver, cheese or as a dessert wine on its own.



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
