<b>VARIETALS</b>	Grenaches and Carignans from vines over 50 years old, with touches of Shiraz, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.
<b>REGION</b>	Montsant

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### WINEMAKING

Controlled fermentation in 50 hl vessels. Long maceration with frequent cap plunging and pumping to achieve the optimal extraction

### TASTING NOTES

The Laurona 2006 has a deep red-purple colour characteristic of its relative youth. Its penetrating bouquet is complex and intense. It initially brings to mind blackcurrants, plums, blackberries and toasted nuts. Little by little, its complexity grows as the wine breathes, and penetrating spice notes appear (vanilla, cinnamon...) as well as a pleasing floral background (violets). Its palate is opulent, velvety and lingering. Its abundant and balanced tannin ensures magnificent aging over the next ten years.

### RATING

"The 2006 Laurona is a blend of Garnacha and Carinena with dollops of Syrah, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon aged for 12 months in 500-liter French oak. Fragrant aromas of Asian spices, incense, licorice, black cherry, and black plum inform the nose of this savory, plush, lengthy effort. It will evolve for 1-2 years and offer prime drinking from 2013 to 2021.
