AOC BORDEAUX 2008

60% Cabernet Sauvignon

40% Merlot

Village location Cocumont:

On the left bank of the Garonne River South-West Bordeaux produces some very robust wines.

Soil:

Stoney, gravel mixed with marl and thick sand

Varieties:

Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting:

Rich red wine with the color of deep ruby. The Nose is expressive and fruity. Supple pleasant and harmonious. The mouth is balanced with fruit, pretty coated structure and harmonious tannins.

Vinification:

In Inox Vats thermo regulated. Fermentation is between 20-25C to keep the freshness of the fruits. Short maceration. Aged in vats.
