

Riesling



Appellation: Elgin, South Africa

Varietal: Weisser Riesling

Alcohol: 11.5%

TA: 6.7 g/l

pH: 3.23

RS: 11.0 g/l

Vinification: The tightness of the Riesling bunches make it susceptible to rot. Since late summer rain was limited this year, rot was largely Botrytis rather than sour rot. Bunch sorting in the vineyard was relatively easy compared to the previous vintage. Harvest started 24 March and ended 25 March. Grapes came in at 42 degrees Brix.

Color: Pale with beautiful green apple tint.

Aroma: Expressive, floral and citrus tones.
