**GRAPE VARIETIES** - PINOTAGE 60% - SHIRAZ 40%

**COLOR** - DARK RED

**AROMA** - BLACKBERRY AND PEPPER

**TASTE** - DAWN EXHIBITS SMOOTH RIPE PLUM AND MILD PEPPER FLAVOURS WITH HINTS OF SPICE. THE WINE IS FIRM BUT HAS SMOOTH TANNINS AND A PLEASANT LONG AFTERTASTE.
