



NAME Valserrano Garnacha 2005
VARIETALS 100% Garnacha
REGION D.O.C. Rioja
ALCOHOL 13.7%

VINIFICATION Due to the favorable conditions that 2005 presented in the region, this is the winery's first effort of a Garnacha monovarietal. The most mature grapes of the harvest undergo slow maceration before spending 16 months in fine-grain French Allier oak. The wine is then bottle-aged for 16 additional months in order to reach its full expression.

TASTING NOTES Violet/red color with cardinal edges. Without moving the glass, the wine exhibits intense redcurrant, and strawberry aromas. Swirling the wine reveals hints of fine wood, elegant and composed, with touches of hay and aromatic herbs. On the palate it is at first smooth and candied. Tannins are well-integrated with flavors of ripe strawberries and chocolate. The finish is long, toasty, and fresh.
