Tasting Notes:

Aroma: Intense and great complexity highlighting notes of raspberry and blackberry, lactic (yoghurt) accompanied by mild roast (coffee).

Color: Very intense cherry, with high layer, clean and bright.

Taste: Easy entry, voluminous, well structured, well-polished soft tannins and with a long finish reminding of fruit compote.

Casa Primicia is a temple of wines whose vineyards stretch from farms in the Sierra de Cantabria to slopes near the Ebro River that are favored by good microclimatic nature. Of all the vineyards, *Carravalseca* is the jewel, which is an ecological farm surrounded by olive trees, in a unique location, in a settlement named after a protected endorheic natural lagoon. The grapes for Bodegas Casa Primicia's wines are delivered to the winery as soon as possible after harvesting to ensure the best possible start to the must fermentation. Following fermentation, the young wine is initially tasted to determine whether it is suited for young or aged wines. The latter is then aged in barrels to bring out their characteristics gradually. The wines of Bodegas Casa Primicia are divided into five lines: young wines, Pure variety wines – typical grape varieties of Rioja, Carravalseca – wines from the grapes of the top vineyards, Julian Madrid – a Tempranillo in honor of the founder, and Cofradía – a long-matured Tempranillo from the *oldest vines*.
