

NARBONA TANNAT BLEND 001

CERRO CHAPEU, Uruguay



This is one of the coolest ideas we have found in wine over the last 5 years. The Narbona Blend from Uruguay is from two separate vintages: 2011 & 2013. That is unusual but not unheard of in wine; *the true mystery* is that the winemakers have decided to not divulge the two different grapes used in the wine. It is their secret, one we have to admire. Having tasted the wine, we can assure you that it is a magnificent red, and a tremendous example of Uruguay's bright wine future. The team at Narbona does not want the consumer to have a preconceived idea about the wine, but instead wants you to try it with an open mind.

Tasting Notes: Intense violet color with hints of ruby. Its nose remembers fresh herbaceous flowers with slight toasted notes. On the palate, it is a full-bodied and persistent wine. The freshness given by acidity stands out together with well integrated tannins. Astringency is enjoyable in the mouth, becoming very elegant and complex.

Limited to only 7000 bottles produced.
